STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE COUNTY-CITY AGREEMENT REGARDING THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEMS AT THE MARIPOSA ROAD INTERSECTIONS OF SOUTH 99 FRONTAGE ROAD WEST AND STAGECOACH ROAD

The City of Stockton and San Joaquin County staff coordinate and participate in the operation, maintenance, interconnection, and coordination of traffic signals throughout the Stockton metropolitan area; and

The State Highway 99 Widening project included new traffic signals at Mariposa Road and Stagecoach Road, and at Mariposa Road and South 99 Frontage Road West. Segments of each intersection are within the City of Stockton and San Joaquin County jurisdictions. The City of Stockton has two of the three legs of the intersection at South 99 Frontage Road West and one of the four legs at Stagecoach Road. The City of Stockton is the lead agency on maintenance and operation of these traffic signals, with San Joaquin County reimbursing the City of Stockton for their share of the costs as noted in the County-City Agreement; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement between the City of Stockton and San Joaquin County to share in the cost to maintain and operate the two traffic signals on Mariposa Road at South 99 Frontage Road West and Stagecoach Road, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
