RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE09-20, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE MYRTLE STREET SANITARY SEWER LINE REHABILITATION, PROJECT NO. M17024

On November 1, 2018, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Myrtle Street Sanitary Sewer Line Rehabilitation, Project No. M17024; and

The project will rehabilitate 3,798 linear feet of 24-inch sanitary sewer pipeline along Myrtle Street between Filbert Street and A Street; and

Insituform Technologies, LLC is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$917,786 and its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15301(B), Class 1, of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE09-20 under CEQA for the Myrtle Street Sanitary Sewer Line Rehabilitation, Project No. M17024, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Myrtle Street Sanitary Sewer Line Rehabilitation, Project No. M17024.
- 3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Insituform Technologies, LLC, in the amount of \$917,786, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.
