RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE09-19, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDING, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE DELLA STREET SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION, PROJECT NO. M17025

On October 25, 2018, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Della Street Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. M17025; and

The project will rehabilitate 1,870 linear feet of 33-inch sanitary sewer line along Della Street, between Hazelton Avenue and Market Street; and

SAK Construction, LLC is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$1,277,410 and its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15301(B), Class 1, of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE09-19 under CEQA for the Della Street Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. M17025, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Della Street Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation. Project No. M17025.
- 3. The City Council approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$625,000 from the Wastewater Utility fund balance (431-0000-287) to the Wastewater/ Sanitary Sewer Deficiency Improvements (437-7787-670) for the Della Street Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. M17025.
- 4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and SAK Construction, LLC, in the amount of \$1,277,410, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
