RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE027-18, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, APPROPRIATING FROM MUNICIPAL UTILITIES DEPARTMENT FUNDING, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE STREET RESURFACING ON FEDERAL-AID STREETS, FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 (PROJECT NO. PW1610/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. STPL-5008(172))

On December 20, 2018, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Street Resurfacing on Federal-Aid Streets Fiscal Year 2016-17 (Project No. PW1610/Federal Project No. STPL-5008(172)); and

The project will resurface Arch Road from B Street to the State Route 99 onramp; March Lane from Feather River Drive to Riverbrook Drive; and Pershing Avenue from March Lane to Brookside Road for a total distance of approximately 3 miles; and

George Reed, Inc. is the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$4,677,754; and

The project is, therefore, awarded to George Reed, Inc., the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$4,677,754, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

Additional funding is required to award the Construction Contract and to construct the project; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15301, Class 1 of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE027-18 under CEQA for the Street Resurfacing on Federal-Aid Streets Fiscal Year 2016-17 (Project No. PW1610/Federal Project No. STPL-5008(172)), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Street Resurfacing on Federal-Aid Streets Fiscal Year 2016-17 (Project No. PW1610/Federal Project No. STPL-5008(172)).

3. The City Council appropriates funds in the amount of \$31,200 from the Water Utility fund balance to the Street Resurfacing on Federal-Aid Streets Fiscal Year 2016-17.

4. The City Council appropriates funds in the amount of \$18,000 from the Wastewater Utility fund balance to the Street Resurfacing on Federal-Aid Streets Fiscal Year 2016-17.

5. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and George Reed, Inc. in the amount of \$4,677,754, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

6. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
