RESOLUTION ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,848, FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR THE UNTESTED SEXUAL ASSAULT EVIDENCE GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2019, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2019; AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 ANNUAL BUDGET; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF GRANT DOCUMENTS

The City of Stockton (City) is interested in participating in the Untested Sexual Assault Evidence Grant Program to be funded by the State of California Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Attorney General; and

The grant is supported by funds allocated with the passage of SB 862, which appropriated funding to the DOJ for grants to city and county agencies in exchange for the compilation of information on the number of untested sexual assault kits (SA kits) in their possession prior to October 1, 2018; and

Following the City's submittal of an application for the grant, the DOJ offered to award the City \$18,848 for the period of January 1, 2019, through June 30, 2019; and

Grant funds will be used for a Stockton Police Department Sergeant's salary and benefits for approximately 208 hours to identify and gather a count of the SA kits; the identified kits will then be transported for testing; and

In order to be considered eligible to receive grant funding, the City must submit a completed Grant Award Memorandum of Understanding to the State of California DOJ; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept the grant award in the amount of \$18,848 for the period of January 1, 2019, through June 30, 2019, and make all necessary appropriations in compliance with and for the purposes stated in the grant application.

2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding, and all related documents necessary and appropriate to carry out the purposes and intent of the grant award and this resolution.

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3. The Fiscal Year 2018-19 Annual Budget is amended to appropriate \$18,848 in revenues and expenditures for the Police Grants and Special Programs accounts as needed to carry out the purpose and intent of this action.
