RESOLUTION APPROVING AN OPTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF STOCKTON AND STOCKTONIANS TAKING ACTION TO NEUTRALIZE DRUGS (STAND) FOR A PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN SOUTH STOCKTON

The City of Stockton (the "City") owns property in South Stockton, inclusive of County Assessor Parcel Numbers 169-163-01 and 169-151-01, more specifically 2222 and 2244 S. Airport Way; and

STAND, a nonprofit Corporation, (the "Developer") has submitted a proposal for the above subject parcels which includes construction of a health clinic, as well as a combination of office space, public meeting and gathering space, affordable housing, and/or retail that serves and provides a benefit to the surrounding neighborhood; and

The City supports the proposed project and the Council authorized an Exclusive Negotiating Rights Agreement in order to negotiate with the Developer on October 18, 2016; and

After negotiations, the terms of a two-year purchase Option Agreement, with a one-year renewal option, have been agreed upon by the Developer; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an Option Agreement with STAND which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. In accordance with section 65402 of the Government Code, the Community Development Department further determined that this action/project conforms to the City's General Plan designation for the site and with the General Plan Policy Document, as amended.
- 3. This project is statutorily exempt under the California Environmental Quality Action (CEQA) Guidelines as specified in section 15332, Class 32 of the State CEQA Guidelines.
