RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE27-19 AND AWARDING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT TO GOES AND NOCETI CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR ON-CALL WATER LINE REPAIR SERVICES

The Municipal Utility Department (MUD) is responsible for repairing and maintaining the water distribution pipelines and equipment that provides Stockton residents with high-quality drinking water; and

During off-hours, an on-call water emergency repair service agreement is needed to avoid prolonged water service outages to the drinking water distribution system; and

Goes and Noceti Construction, Inc., doing business as G&N Construction, provided a bid in the Not-to-Exceed amount of \$1,745,375 over a five-year contract term; and

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, section 15301(b) of the CEQA Guidelines; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Authorize the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE27-19 under CEQA for On-Call Water Line Repair Services, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. Award a Professional Services Agreement to Goes and Noceti Construction, Inc., doing business as G&N Construction, of Stockton, CA, in the amount of \$1,745,375 over a five-year contract term, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Manager is hereby necessary and appropriate to carry out the part of the part	authorized to take whatever actions are purpose and intent of this Resolution.
