RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF WATER LINE EASEMENTS FOR THE VETERANS AFFAIRS CLINIC OFF-SITE UTILITIES IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (PROJECT NO. M20026)

On December 10, 2019, the City Council approved the Veterans Affairs Clinic Off-Site Utilities Improvements Project (the "Project") and associated environmental documents to facilitate the development of the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs facility ("VA Facility"); and

To facilitate the design and construction of the water and sewer utility services for the project, the Municipal Utilities Department (MUD) will complete the design and construct connection-ready utility service or the VA Facility to secure domestic water service from City's water reservoirs at 738 West French Camp Road, San Joaquin County Assessor Parcel Number 193-060-49; and

The Project requires the acquisition of both permanent water line easements and temporary construction easements at 817 West Yettner Road to complete the final phase of the project; and

The subject water line easement and temporary construction easement is owned by The Long Family; and

Staff negotiated a suitable purchase price of \$155,000 plus closing costs for the easements; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to acquire water line and temporary construction easements for the Veterans Affairs Clinic Off-Site Utilities Improvements Project (Project No. M20026) (Exhibit 1 – Acquisition Agreement).

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2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions a necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.	are
