Taylor Street for the City of Stockton

The Community Development Department received a request to review the above-referenced project for conformity with the Stockton General Plan and make an environmental determination pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The City of Stockton's Economic Development Department is requesting an abandonment at the right-of-way center line intersection of Lt. Col. Mark Taylor Street and Nash Drive.

In accordance with Government Code §65402, the Community Development Department determines the project is in conformance with the Stockton General Plan. This determination is based on, but not limited to, conformance with General Plan Policy, LU-6.3 (Land Use) stating, "Ensure that all neighborhoods have access to well-maintained public facilities and utilities that meet community service needs."

Concerning the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determination, the Community Development Department concludes the project is Categorically Exempt under CEQA Guidelines §15301(C) because it requests the minor alteration of existing street for the purpose of public safety. The project is also not subject to any of the exceptions to the use of a Categorical Exemption listed at CEQA Guidelines §15300.2.

Upon approval by City Council, the draft Notice of Exemption (NOE45-20) attached hereto as Attachment A should be filed and posted in the San Joaquin County Clerk Office to initiate a 35-day statute of limitations on court challenges. Please retain a copy of the original posted notice within the project file in the Public Works Department.

COMMENCING at the right-of-way center line intersection of Lt Col Mark Taylor Street and Nash Drive as shown on that certain map entitled "Tract No. 3523, Cannery Park Unit No. 3 – Village G1" filed for record in Book 43 of Maps and Plats, Page 103, San Joaquin County Records; thence North 90°00'00" West along the right-of-way center line of said Lt Col Mark Taylor Street, a distance of 205.00 feet to THE POINT OF BEGINNING of this description; thence leaving last said line South 0°00'00" West 48.00 feet to the Southerly right-of-way line of said Lt Col Mark Taylor Street; thence along said Southerly right-of-way line the following three (3) courses: (1) thence North 90°00'00" West 41.99 feet to beginning of a tangent curve concave to the South having a radius of 1952.00 feet; (2) thence along said curve through a central angle of 9°02'45" an arc distance of 308.18 feet, and a chord course of South 85°28'37" West 307.86 feet; (3) thence South 80°57'15" West 519.95 feet to the East line of 400-feet Congressional Grant as shown on said Tract 3465; thence North 3°44'08" East along said East line of 400-feet Congressional Grant, a distance of 98.44 feet to the Northerly line of said Lt Col Mark Taylor Street; thence along the Northerly right-of-way line of said Lt Col Mark Taylor Street the following three (3) courses: (1) thence North 80°57'15" East 498.18 feet to beginning of a tangent curve concave to the South having a radius of 2048.00 feet; (2) thence along said curve through a central angle of 9°02'45" an arc distance of 323.34 feet, and a chord course of North 85°28'37" East 323.00 feet; (3) thence North 90°00'00" East 47.06 feet; thence leaving last said line South 9°15'33" West 26.69 feet to beginning of a tangent curve concave to the East having a radius of 60.00 feet; thence along said curve through a central angle of 9°15'33" an arc distance of 9.70 feet, and a chord course of South 4°37'47" West 9.69 feet; thence South 0°00/00" East 12.00 feet to THE POINT OF BEGINNING.


