RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE41-19, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 2014 SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION–PHASE 2, PROJECT NO. M19001

On June 11, 2020, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation – Phase 2, Project No. M19001; and

The project will rehabilitate 1,428 linear feet of sanitary sewer line on Kentfield Road from March Lane to Coventry Road; Rose Street from Sutter Street to California Street; California Street from Rose Street to Vine Street; an easement north of Park Street from Carlton Avenue to Wilshire Avenue; and El Dorado Street from Anderson Street to Jefferson Street; and

California Trenchless, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$395,050, and its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, section 15301(d), of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE41-19 under CEQA for the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation–Phase 2, Project No. M19001, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation–Phase 2, Project No. M19001.
3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and California Trenchless, Inc., in the amount of \$395,050, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

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4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
