RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE-44-20, APPROVING THE PROJECT PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO PIPING AND CORROSION SPECIALTIES, INC. FOR THE SANITARY SEWER PUMP STATIONS AND FORCEMAINS CATHODIC PROTECTION IMPROVEMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$562,098 (PROJECT NO. M17014)

On August 13, 2020 , the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed bids offered for the Sanitary Sewer Pump Stations and Force mains Cathodic Protection Improvements (Project No. M17014); and

Piping and Corrosion Specialties, Inc., is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$562,098; and

The bid submitted by Piping and Corrosion Specialties, Inc. is regular and responsive in all respects; and

The project conforms with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, section 15301 (b), of the CEQA Guidelines; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE44-20 under CEQA for the Sanitary Sewer Pump Stations and Force mains Cathodic Protection Improvements (Project No. M17014) is approved, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the project plans and specifications for the Sanitary Sewer Pump Stations and Force mains Cathodic Protection Improvements (Project No. M17014).

3. A \$562,098 Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Piping and Corrosion Specialties, Inc., of Millersville, Maryland, is awarded for the Sanitary Sewer Pump Stations and Force mains Cathodic Protection Improvements (Project No. M17014), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
