RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 PROJECT LIST FOR THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017 AND AUTHORIZE SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS TO THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

On April 28, 2017, the Governor signed Senate Bill 1 (SB1), known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017. The funding provides for basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety needs on both the State highway and local streets and road systems; and

The Legislature tasked the California Transportation Commission (CTC) with oversight of funding and/or programs created with the approval of SB1; and

SB1 funds the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) Program. The RMRA funding is part of the overall Gas Tax allocation; however, RMRA funds can only be expended on projects that meet eligibility criteria and have been approved by the CTC; and

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 RMRA funding allocation for the City is estimated to be \$6,184,000; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the FY 2021-22 project list for the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
2. The City Council authorizes the Public Works Director or his/her designee to submit all necessary reports to the CTC related to the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.
3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
