The Homeless Employment Litter Program (HELP) has given California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), District 10 Stockton, an opportunity to partner with the City of Stockton and the non-profit group Ready to Work (RTW) to provide litter abatement in and around the city.

Additional funding, in the amount of \$75,000, will be made available for expenditures under the terms of the Delegated Maintenance Agreement (DMA) with the City of Stockton dated September 6, 2018. The additional funding is a one-time increase and augments the authorized annual amount of \$121,000 stipulated in Exhibit A of the DMA. The availability of the additional funds will expire on June 30, 2022.

This letter is a request for modification to the current Delegated Maintenance Agreement, signed on September 6, 2018.
