WHEREAS, the City and Contractor entered into a Professional Services Agreement for the Homeless Employment Litter Program (Project No. OM-18-093) dated September 27, 2018 ("the Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor executed Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement for Professional Service ("Amendment No. 1") dated March 6, 2019; and Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement for Professional Service ("Amendment No. 2") dated May 20, 2019; and Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement for Professional Service ("Amendment No. 3") dated May 27, 2020; and mutually extended the Agreement for Professional Service for one-year through August 31, 2022, for a total contract amount of \$663,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 7. states this Agreement may make such alterations, deviations, additions to or omissions from the plans and specifications, including the right to increase or decrease the quantity of any item or portion of the work, as may be deemed by the Project Manager to be necessary or advisable and to require such extra work as may be determined by the Project Manager to be required for the proper completion of the whole work contemplated; and

WHEREAS, the City has a need to increase Compensation, by an additional one-time increase of \$75,000, to pay for adding more days, hours, and more frequent roadside clean-ups; now therefore,

WHEREAS, this amendment is for the mutual benefit of City and Contractor;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and Contractor agree as follows:

1. Section 2., paragraph 1, sentence 4 – is amended and restated:

"Total compensation for services and reimbursement for costs shall not exceed \$738,000 or as otherwise mutually agreed to in a Contract Change Order."

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2. Except as stated herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged.
