RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE24-21, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE RULE 20A DOWNTOWN STREET LIGHTING PROGRAM, PROJECT NO. WT15021

On May 6, 2021, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Rule 20A Downtown Street Lighting Program, Project No. WT15021 (formerly PW1521); and

The project will remove the streetlights from the existing utility poles and re-establish them on City standard streetlight poles within the Downtown Underground Utility District; and

Bear Electrical Solutions, Inc. is the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$70,210, and its bid is regular in all respects; and

Caltrans National Environmental Policy Act determination was received on September 14, 2018. The State determined that the project is a Categorical Exclusion under 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c)(3). Similarly, the project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code section 65402; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15302(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE24-21 under the CEQA for the Rule 20A Downtown Street Lighting Program, Project No. WT15021 (formerly PW1521), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Rule 20A Downtown Street Lighting Program, Project No. WT15021 (formerly PW1521).

3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Bear Electrical Solutions, Inc. in the amount of \$70,210, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
