RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF FOUR MEMBERS TO THE CULTURAL HERITAGE BOARD

The Cultural Heritage Board (CHB) is a nine-member citizen advisory body charged with the preservation and protection of the City's historical, architectural, and cultural resources; and

Currently, four vacancies exist on the CHB; and

The Planning Commission, during its regularly scheduled public meeting of June 24, 2021, voted to appoint Tejpaul Bainiwal, Bryan Baldeon, Mary Jo Gohlke, and Matt Holmes to the CHB subject to City Council approval; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 16.220.040 of the Stockton Municipal Code, the City Council hereby approves the appointment of Tejpaul Bainiwal, Bryan Baldeon, and Mary Jo Gohlke to the CHB, effective immediately, to serve the remaining unexpired period of the terms that will expire on October 31, 2022.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 16.220.040 of the Stockton Municipal Code, the City Council hereby approves the appointment of Matt Holmes to the CHB, effective November 1, 2021, to serve a four-year term that will expire on October 31, 2025.
- 3. The City Manager is authorized to take any and all necessary and appropriate actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
