RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR THE OUTDOOR EQUITY GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS FOR WILLIAMS BROTHERHOOD PARK OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL PROGRAMMING

The State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of the Outdoor Equity Grants Program, setting up necessary procedures governing the application; and

Said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the Applicant to certify by resolution the approval of the application before submission of said application to the State; and

Successful Applicants will enter into a contract with the State of California to complete the Grant Scope program; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Hereby approves the filing of an application for the Williams Brotherhood Park Outdoor Recreational Programming.
2. Certifies that said Applicant has or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on the program(s) included in this application, the sufficient funds to complete the program(s).
3. Certifies that if the grant is awarded, the Applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate the program(s) as described in the Grant Selection Criterion response.
4. Certifies that the Applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide.
5. Delegates the authority to the City Manager to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Grant Scope.
6. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and guidelines.
7. Will consider promoting inclusion per Public Resources Code section 80001(b)(8 A-G).

8. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
