RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE02-21, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE HOWARD STREET, PILGRIM STREET, AND UNION STREET SANITARY SEWER LINE REHABILITATION, PROJECT NOS. UW18031 AND UW18032

On June 17, 2021, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Howard Street, Pilgrim Street, and Union Street Sanitary Sewer Line Rehabilitation, Project Nos. UW18031 and UW18032 (formerly M18031 and M18032); and

The project will rehabilitate a combined total of 732 linear feet of sanitary sewer line located within sewer easements located south of Howard Street, and between the southern termini of Pilgrim Street and Union Street; and

California Trenchless, Inc. is the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$258,370, and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(b) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption NOE02-21 under the CEQA for the Howard Street, Pilgrim Street, and Union Street Sanitary Sewer Line Rehabilitation, Project Nos. UW18031 and UW18032, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Howard Street, Pilgrim Street, and Union Street Sanitary Sewer Line Rehabilitation, Project Nos. UW18031 and UW18032.

3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and California Trenchless, Inc., in the amount of \$258,370, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
