RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE41-21, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE LONG LINE RE-STRIPING, PROJECT NO. WD21009

On June 17, 2021, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Long Line Re-striping, Project No. WD21009; and

The project will re-stripe approximately 19 centerline miles citywide. The project includes refreshing long-line striping for traffic lanes that are worn. Existing worn traffic stripes will be primed, and a new coat of thermoplastic material will be applied; and

PCI is the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$124,170, and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE41-21 under the CEQA for the Long Line Re-striping, Project No. WD21009, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Long Line Re-striping, Project No. WD21009 (formerly PW2109).
- 3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and PCI in the amount of \$124,170, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby a necessary and appropriate to carry out the pur	uthorized to take whatever actions are pose and intent of this Resolution.
