RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A STRUCTURE OF MERIT FOR THE 'KENDALL' BUILDING LOCATED AT 430 EAST WEBER STREET (APPLICATION NO. P18-0855)

On November 14, 2018, a nomination was submitted by Mr. William Maxwell for a Structure of Merit designation for the 'Kendall' building (currently vacant) located at 430 East Weber Street (APN 149-170-30); and

Stockton Municipal Code (SMC) section 16.22.100 provides the process and criteria for Structure of Merit designation; and

On October 6, 2021, the Cultural Heritage Board considered the application at their regularly scheduled meeting; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CULTURAL HERITAGE BOARD OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

B. Based on its review of the entire record herein, the Cultural Heritage Board makes the following findings:

Structure of Merit

1. The information provided in Exhibit 1 (Nomination), a copy of which is attached here and incorporated by this reference, satisfies the criteria at SMC section 16.220.100(A) and demonstrates a Structure of Merit designation is appropriate and furthers the purposes of SMC Chapter 16.220 (Cultural Resources).
