## STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT 2020 STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT

The Stockton Fire Department ("SFD") applied for a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) seeking funds to assist the City in hiring nine (9) Firefighters; and

On September 10, 2021, SFD was notified by FEMA that the City of Stockton was awarded \$4,810,101.03 for the 2020 SAFER Grant to hire nine (9) Firefighter positions for three (3) years; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager is authorized to accept grant funds from FEMA for the 2020 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant in the amount of \$4,810,101.03, to hire nine (9) Firefighters for three (3) years.
- 2. The City Manager is directed to make all necessary budget appropriations for the purposes stated in the grant agreement.
- 3. Total authorized full-time positions are increased by nine grant-funded firefighter positions.
- 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
