RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE33-21, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE FIRE STATION NOS. 3, 4, 5, 7, 10, 11, & 14 EXTERIOR PAINTING, PROJECT NO. F017006

On September 23, 2021, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Fire Station Nos. 3, 4, 5, 7, 10, 11, & 14 Exterior Painting, Project No. F017006; and

The project will paint the exteriors of Fire Station Nos. 3, 4, 5, 7, 10, 11, & 14 including the roofs of Fire Station Nos. 5 and 14. The painting also includes out buildings, light poles, fences, gates, bollards, and storage containers within the premises of the fire stations; and

Yoda Painting, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$163,000, and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(a) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE33-21 under the CEQA for the Fire Station Nos. 3, 4, 5, 7, 10, 11, & 14 Exterior Painting, Project No. F017006, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Fire Station Nos. 3, 4, 5, 7, 10, 11, & 14 Exterior Painting, Project No. F017006.
- 3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Yoda Painting, Inc., in the amount of \$163,000, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
