P3. Description (Describe resource and its major elements. Include design, materials, condition, alterations, size, setting, and boundaries)

This stucco clad building is located on the southeastern corner of N. Grant and E. Rose Streets. The structure is a two-story building with a steep gable roof covered with tile. The north side of the roof has a hipped dormer with two attic vents. Large multi-paned windows create a symmetrical fenestration. The first floor windows have awnings. The main entrance is at the southern side of the building. The entrance is recessed into the building with large concrete blocks surrounding the opening. Above the entrance is a large multi-paned awning window with geometric plaster work. The building is irregular in plan with 6,192 square feet and appears to be in good condition.

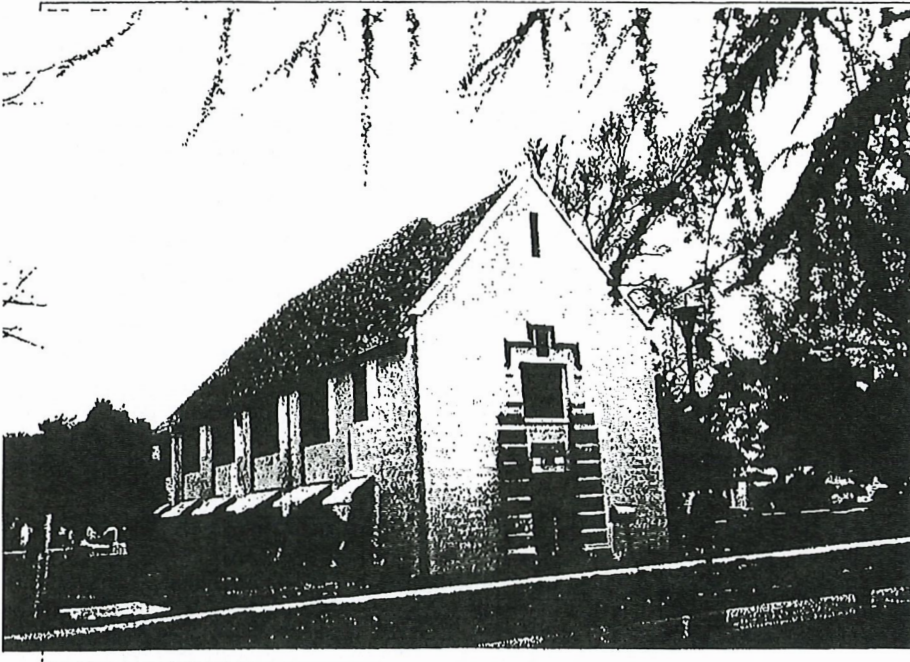

Lastly, this resource qualifies for protection under the City of Stockton's Historic Preservation Ordinance as a contributor to a local historic preservation district significant under ordinance Criterion B: resources associated with an event that has made a substantial contribution to the broad patterns of our history. Per the City's Ordinance, more than thirty percent (30%) of the resources, not including accessory uses, natural features and sites, within the boundaries of this historic district are significant.
