RESOLUTION APPROVING NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE4-22, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 2020-21 SANITARY SEWER MAINTENANCE HOLE REHABILITATION, PROJECT NO. UW20011

On January 19, 2023, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the 2020-21 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation, Project No. UW20011; and

The Municipal Utilities Department performs ongoing inspection and maintenance of the City's sanitary sewer collection system and identified 25 sanitary sewer maintenance holes throughout the City that are severely deteriorated due to either high corrosive gas levels or high groundwater infiltration levels; and

The project will rehabilitate 25 sanitary sewer maintenance holes which includes removing and replacing damaged material and applying an epoxy coating to the wall surfaces of the existing maintenance holes; and

The lowest bid from Paulson Cox Construction, Inc. was deemed irregular due to failure to meet the 30 percent minimum requirement of contract work to be performed by the prime contractor; and

Lamassu Utility Services, Inc. is the second lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$357,990.91, and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE4-22 under CEQA for the 2020-21 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation, Project No. UW20011, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the 2020-21 Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Hole Rehabilitation, Project No. UW20011.

3. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Lamassu Utility Services, Inc., in the amount of \$357,990.91, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
