RESOLUTION TO CREATE NEW CLASS SPECIFICATIONS OF EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS MANAGER AND FIRE SERVICES ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND APPROVE THE PROPOSED SALARY RANGES

It is necessary to establish two new classifications of Emergency Communications Manager (Classified/Represented) and Fire Services Administrator (Classified/Unrepresented) to provide administrative and technical leadership in and oversight of the Fire Department's Emergency Communications Division and the Administrative Bureau respectively; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The new class specifications are hereby created with the salaries approved as follows:
