

§ 10.04.600 Use of streets for storage of vehicles prohibited.

- A. No person who owns or has possession, custody or control of any vehicle shall park or leave such vehicle standing upon any street or alley for more than a period of 72 consecutive hours or more. For purposes of this section, a vehicle shall be considered to have been parked or left standing for 72 or more consecutive hours if it has remained inoperable or has not been moved at least 300 feet from its previous stopping point during said 72-hour period. In the event a vehicle is parked or left standing upon a street in excess of a period of 72 consecutive hours such vehicle may be removed in the manner and subject to the requirements of Article I of Chapter 10.16.
- B. Police officers, officers, or parking enforcement officers are hereby authorized to issue a citation provided for in the California Vehicle Code whenever he or she has reasonable cause to believe that a violation of this section has occurred in his or her presence.
