RESOLUTION DECLARING ELECTION RESULTS OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON PRIMARY MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF JUNE 2, 2026

A Primary Municipal Election was consolidated with the State of California Primary Election held on June 2, 2026, pursuant to Stockton City Charter Article VII; and

The San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters ("Registrar") was authorized to canvass the returns of the election; and

The Registrar has conducted the canvass and stated the results in the "Certification of the Tuesday, June 2, 2026, Presidential Primary Election"; and

California Elections Code sections 10262, 10263, and 10264 require the adoption of a resolution reciting the fact of the election and a statement of the results; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The whole number of votes cast in the City of Stockton was 21,999 as confirmed by the Registrar.
2. The names of the persons voted for, the offices for which they were voted, and the total number of votes given in the City to each person are as set forth in the Certificate of Results prepared by the Registrar, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and incorporated herein.
3. The number of votes given to each person is as set forth in an excerpt from the Statement of Votes Cast as prepared by the Registrar, attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein.
4. No candidate in the race for District 1 received a majority of the votes cast. As such, District 1 candidates Michele Padilla and Tamica Small will advance to the General Municipal Election on the November 3, 2026.
5. No candidate in the race for District 3 received a majority of the votes cast. As such, District 3 candidates Michael Blower and Jessica Toccoli will advance to the General Municipal Election on the November 3, 2026.

6. No candidate in the race for District 5 received a majority of the votes cast. As such, District 5 candidates Brando Villapudua and Desiree Lynch will advance to the General Municipal Election on the November 3, 2026.
