ADOPT A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A POSITION IN THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR

Article XI, Section 1102, paragraph (n) of the City Charter authorizes the Mayor, with the advice and consent of Council, to appoint employees to the Office of the Mayor as may be necessary or desirable to assist in the work of the Mayor; and

Measure O, approved by voters on November 8, 2016, amended the Charter to require funding for no less than three Mayoral staff positions to be included in each annual budget; and

These positions include an Executive Assistant, a Senior Policy Advisor, and a Public Information Officer; and

To comply with Measure O, and Article XI-A, Section 1151 of the City Charter, a Public Information Officer must be one of the three positions funded and assigned to the Office of the Mayor; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby approves the appointment of one new employee to fill the vacant Mayoral Public Information Officer position in the Office of the Mayor.
 - Jason Teramoto as the Mayoral Public Information Officer
- 2. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of the resolution.
