Project Description/Location: The City of Stockton's Economic Development Department is seeking grant funding from the Division of Boating and Waterways (DBAW) to support future improvements to the Louis Park Boat Launch facility. The funding, through the Waters Connection Initiative grant, will enable the City to contract with an engineering firm to develop plans for the proposed enhancements, as outlined in Attachment A – Louis Park Boat Launch Conceptualized Plans. These potential improvements include the addition of an ADA-compliant pathway, a low-profile dock, a boat washing station, enhanced lighting, and a terraced viewing area.
