RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE78-21, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SAFETY AND CONNECTIVITY IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT NO. WT19005 / FEDERAL PROJECT NO. ATPCML-5008(189)

On June 6, 2024, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed bids offered for the Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005/Federal Project No. ATPCML-5008(189); and

The project will construct bicycle lanes, missing sidewalk segments, install high visibility crosswalks, with rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFB), and upgrade existing curb ramps to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards near six elementary/middle and high schools; and

Dirt Dynasty, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$5,521,230, and its bid is responsive and regular in all respects; and

The project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines. The activities related to this project constitute a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project that does not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$210,000 from the Traffic Signal Public Facilities Fee Fund Balance to the Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005/Federal Project No. ATPSCML-5008(189).
- 2. The City Council approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$340,000 from the Street Improvements Public Facilities Fee Fund Balance to the Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005/Federal Project No. ATPSCML-5008(189).
- 3. The City Council approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$1,040,353 from the Air Quality Public Facilities Fee Fund Balance to the Safe Routes to

School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No WT19005/Federal Project No. ATPSCML-5008(189).

- 4. The City Council approves the transfer of funds in the amount of \$373,393 of Measure K funds from the Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005, to the Measure K Fund Balance.
- 5. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE78-21 under CEQA for the Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005/Federal Project No. ATPCML-5008(189), attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 6. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements, Project No. WT19005/Federal Project No. ATPCML-5008(189).
- 7. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Dirt Dynasty, Inc., in the amount of \$5,521,230, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 8. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
