- Established by City at the request of Lodging Business Community
- Stockton Convention and Visitor's Bureau was contracted to Manage and provide marketing and tourism attraction services for the STBID.
- STBID requires that a budget and Management District Plan be created and approved annually by Council

## STBID Background



- ► Jul Sept Hoteliers sign petition to renew
- Oct 1 Council adopted Resolution of Intent to Renew
- Oct 4 Notice of Intent to renew mailed to Lodging Businesses
- Nov 2 Notice regarding public meeting and hearing mailed to lodging businesses
- Nov 12 Hold Public Meeting, receive public testimony
- Nov 19 Hold Public Hearing and take action on Renewal Resolutions

## STBID Process



 Modify the current Management District Plan to end early on December 31, 2024;

## Declaring the results of the protest period - the majority supports the renewal and modification;

- Approving the modified Management District Plan to include a 1% assessment increase to 5%, with 0.5% increase in year six to 5.5%;
- Approving the renewal of the STBID, effective January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2035; and
- Approving an amendment to the management agreement with Stockton Convention and Visitors Bureau modifying the term to extend through December 31, 2035.
