RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONTRACT AMENDMENT NO. 2 WITH BRENNTAG PACIFIC LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$280,000 TO PURCHASE SODIUM HYDROXIDE FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT

The Municipal Utilities Department (MUD) operates and maintains the Regional Wastewater Control Facility (RWCF), an advanced tertiary wastewater treatment facility with a 55 million-gallon per day capacity, located adjacent to the San Joaquin River; and

Various chemical compounds are commonly used under state and federal regulations in wastewater treatment to remove impurities, improve water quality, and protect public health; and

The RWCF currently uses sodium hydroxide for adjusting pH in the aeration basins that were installed as part of the new RWCF Modifications Project; and

On May 13, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution 2025-05-13-1215, authorizing a contract with Brenntag Pacific LLC (Brenntag) in the amount of \$544,000 for the purchase of sodium hydroxide for wastewater treatment. The contract expires on June 30, 2026; and

Contract Amendment No. 1 added \$154,000, amending the not-to-exceed contract amount to \$687,000; and

During the past year, the amount of sodium hydroxide used at the RWCF has increased significantly due to RWCF Modifications Project treatment processes; and

Staff reviewed the average monthly sodium hydroxide usage for the first ten months of the fiscal year and determined that an additional \$280,000 is needed to ensure sufficient funding for chemical purchases; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Amendment No. 2, adding \$280,000 to the contract with Brenntag Pacific LLC for a total contract amount of \$978,000, is hereby approved, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
