RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS, APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE36-24, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE ALPINE AND ALVARADO CONVERSION TO 3-WAY TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT

On October 30, 2025, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Alpine and Alvarado Conversion to 3-Way Traffic Signal, Project No. WT21012/Federal Project No. CML-5008(193); and

The project will install a dedicated 3-way traffic signal at the intersection of Alpine Avenue and Alvarado Avenue, update lane striping, and install Americans with Disabilities Act compliant crosswalks; and

St. Francis Electric, LLC is the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$826,270 and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council authorizes the transfer of funds in the amount of \$50,000 from the Grant Match Program, Project No. WT21016, to the Alpine and Alvarado Conversion to 3-Way Traffic Signal, Project No. WT21012/Federal Project No. CML-5008(193).

2. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE36-24 under the CEQA for the Alpine and Alvarado Conversion to 3-Way Traffic Signal, Project No. WT21012/Federal Project No. CML-5008(193), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Alpine and Alvarado Conversion to 3-Way Traffic Signal, Project No. WT21012/Federal Project No. CML-5008(193).

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and St. Francis Electric, LLC, in the amount of \$826,270, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
