

§ 16.76.090. Illegal signs.

- A. **Illegal Signs in the Public Right-of-Way.** Illegal signs posted in the public right-of-way or upon public property may be removed by Public Works and/or the Police Department without notice or hearing in compliance with Section 12.80.030 of the Municipal Code.
- B. **Authority to Abate.** The Director is authorized to abate illegal signs on private property after five days' notice.
- C. **Authority to Remove.** The Director may cause the immediate removal, without notice, of any sign that becomes insecure, in danger of falling or is otherwise deemed unsafe by the code enforcement official.
- D. **Recovery of Costs.** When the City is required to remove illegal signs in compliance with this section, the reasonable cost of the removal may be assessed against the owner of the sign(s) and/or the property owner.
