Firearms Unit Statistics

- Integrated Ballistic Identification System (IBIS) entries made by SPD's National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) Technicians
- High Confidence correlations made by trained SPD NIBIN Technicians
 - High Confidence- When a technician determines evidence entered is linked to other crime(s) and/or crime gun that was recovered. High Confidences are used for investigative purposes.
- Crime involved guns recovered by SPD are fired for testing and entry into the IBIS system
- Hits are confirmed by DOJ when needed for court as SPD currently has no contract Firearms Examiner



Financial Summary

| Agency | Formula Allocation | Proposed Reallocation |
