The City has met HHAP Rounds 1 through 4 obligation requirements and is on target to meet Round 5 as well. Expenditure requirements are on target as well for all rounds. A portion of Round 3 funds have been contracted to provide low-barrier shelter operations with St. Mary's Community Services, and about half of Round 3 and Round 4 funds were obligated from permanent housing funding, including the Youth Set-Aside requirement. Those projects are Calaveras Quarters and Satellite Apartments, contracted through the Delta Community Development Corp.

The Regional HHAP 5 award announcement came in the fall of 2024. The contract arrived at the end of December 2024 and was fully executed in January 2025. The City's funding allocation for HHAP 5 is \$7,153,178.87 and is based on HUD certification of the 2023 Point in Time Count findings for all jurisdictions. The City received at the end of February the initial disbursement of HHAP 5 in the amount of \$4,027,005.24. Obligation and expenditure requirements for each Round of HHAP, as shown below.
