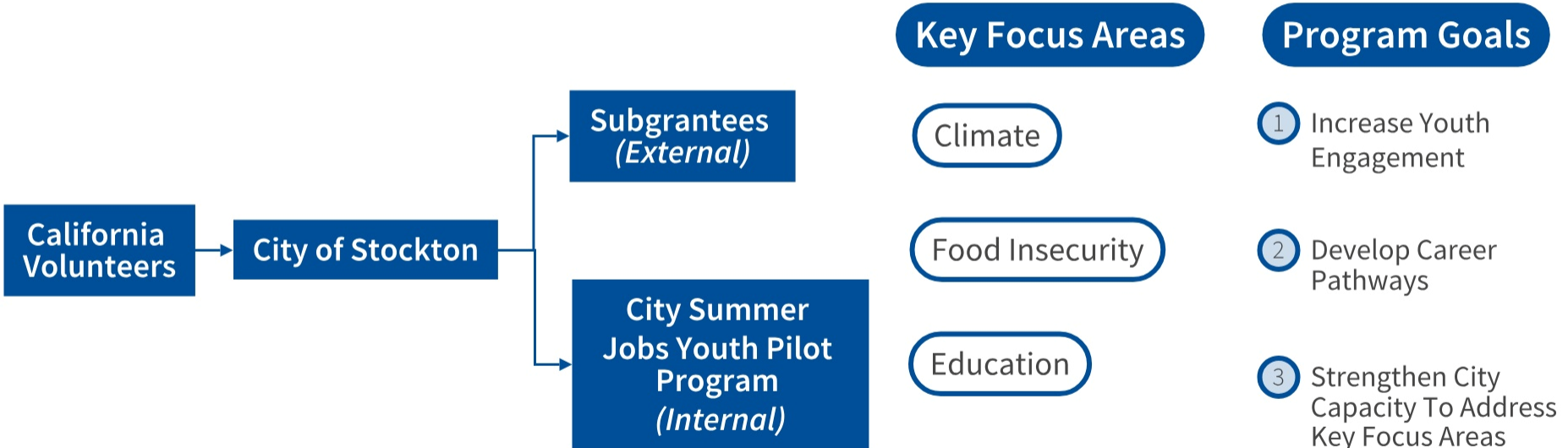

Process to Identify Subgrantees

- **Request for Proposals**

- Staff issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) in 2022 and 2024 for CFA Round 1 and 2, respectively.
- The RFP invited local workforce entities to submit their programs for consideration to receive the CA4All grant funding. The only requirement was that their program meet the requirements of the grant itself.
- City received more proposals than could be funded for both rounds -- staff recommended the most competitive and impactful programs for funding.
