RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS, APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE48-23, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE CITYWIDE SYSTEMIC ROAD SAFETY DEVICES PROJECT

On October 9, 2025, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Citywide Systemic Road Safety Devices, Project No. WT22043/State Project No. HSIPSL-5008(219); and

The project will install 27 solar-powered radar speed feedback signs at various locations Citywide. The project improvements also include the purchase and installation of three radar speed feedback trailer; and

St. Francis Electric, LLC is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$377,976 and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is categorically exempt from the requirements of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(f) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council authorizes the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$87,797 from the Public Facilities Fee Air Quality fund balance to the Citywide Systemic Road Safety Devices, Project No. WT22043/State Project No. HSIPSL-5008(219).
2. The City Council authorizes the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$152,470 from the Highway Safety Improvement Program funds to the Citywide Systemic Road Safety Devices, Project No. WT22043/State Project No. HSIPSL-5008(219).
3. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE48-23 under the CEQA for the Citywide Systemic Road Safety Devices, Project No. WT22043/State Project No. HSIPSL-5008(219), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Citywide Systemic Road Safety Devices, Project No. WT22043/State Project No. HSIPSL-5008(219).

5. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and St. Francis Electric, LLC, in the amount of \$377,976, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

6. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
