RESOLUTION TO AWARD A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT TO WALLACE ROBERTS & TODD, LLC, FOR THE DOWNTOWN STOCKTON MASTER PLAN AND VISIONING PROJECT

In April 2024, City Council authorized an application to the San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) for the receipt of \$969,000.00 in Regional Early Action Planning 2.0 (REAP 2.0) funds. In May 2025, City Council authorized an amended application to SJCOG for an additional \$855,200.96 in REAP 2.0 for a total allocation of \$1,824,200.96; and

In April 2025, the City published a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify and select a firm to prepare the Downtown Stockton Master Plan and Visioning document (PUR25-038), whereby ten proposals were received; and

After reviewing and scoring the proposals, it was determined that Wallace Roberts & Todd, LLC (WRT) has the necessary knowledge, experience, staff, and subcontractors to perform the required work. Staff determined a price of \$1,027,340.00 for WRT to develop the Downtown Stockton Master Plan and Visioning document and associated activities; and

The project includes other activities to further activate existing assets and amenities that cannot utilize REAP 2.0 funding, including the exploration of an Entertainment District and new activation opportunities; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Award a Professional Services Agreement in the amount not to exceed \$1,027,340.00 to Wallace Roberts & Todd, LLC, for the Downtown Stockton Master Plan and Visioning Project.
- 2. Authorize a budget amendment to appropriate \$154,965.00 from the Redevelopment Sub-fund for this contract.
- 3. Authorize the City Manager to execute the Agreement substantially similar in form to Attachment A.
