I have spent my entire life advocating for, and using public transit, trains, buses, and ferries. I have worked in all four categories of the bus business, Intercity (Long Distance), Charter, Transit, and School Bus (Yellow). I wish to influence a measurable shift in San Joaquin County of auto-dependent transportation to transit and active/pedestrian transportation. I wish to greatly increase RTD's ridership and significantly improve its operating economics through increased fare revenues and efficient bus operations. I wish to make RTD a completely modern transit system that is relevant to, and the pride of Stockton and County residents. I have worked many types of jobs in my bus employment. My intercity employment for Trailways, Inc, included: District Operations Manager of a four-state area based in Las Vegas, Nev., Terminal Manager in San Francisco, Oakland, and Las Vegas, Ticket Agent and Phone Information Clerk in San Francisco, Bus Service Maintenance in Flagstaff, Ariz., and Chief Dispatcher of the West Coast in Los Angeles. My employment with Amador Stage Lines in Sacramento included, Chief Dispatcher for Charter Operations. At the San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) I was Director of Planning, Manager of Service Development, and Senior Planning over a 17 year tenure. My RTD responsibilities and duties included, designing fixed routes and schedules, deviated route/mobility services, gathering, analyzing, and reporting ridership data to Federal, State, and Local government agencies, conducting public hearings, reporting key performance measures to funding agencies, operating and fare recovery costs, and producing mandatory government transit reports such as Unmet Transit Needs, Title VI, Short Range Transit Plans, and Triennial Reports and Audits. My employment with Stockton Unified School District (SUSD) was Director of Transportation. My SUSD responsibilities and duties were to manage all Yellow School Bus Operations including school route implementation, State-Mandated Special Education door-to-door service, dispatching of operations, employee assignments, payroll, and discipline, bus garage and district fleet maintenance, and procurement of all transportation vehicles and equipment. In conclusion, I have worked in all phases of transit and bus operations in a 24 year career and have worked nearly all positions in bus operations. This employment includes: Executive Management, Service Planning, Government Reporting, System Budgeting and Financial Planning, Department and Employee Managing, and Bus Fleet Maintenance, and Procurement. Notably I have procured, and designed service for, Diesel-Hybrid, Terminal Quick-Charge, and Depart-Charging Electric Buses for Zero Emission Vehicle (BEL and ZEV) Operations. My Staff and I also designed innovation Deviated-Fixed Metro and County Hopper Routes (featured in a New Jersey Transit International Paper), Bus Rapid Transit (BRT Service), Limited Peak Hour Route Service designed to safely and economically transport SUSD students, and Trolley Bus service for Sporting and Community Events. I have the most practical and useful institutional knowledge of RTD transit service dating back to 1986. I have also been a licensed bus driver and know what the challenges are with driving a 45-foot vehicle.

I have been an advocate, and a user of, public transportation for over 60 years. It has been a primary goal of my entire life to encourage and promote a measurable shift of transportation usage in the United States, and locally in Stockton and San Joaquin County, from automobiles to public transit and active transportation of bicycle and pedestrian trips. This shift is extremely important for the economic and environmental health of our region. I understand the finances of transit service from operating costs and fare revenues and recovery ratios to the subsidized funding sources. I understand that while transit is a subsidized business, it is also a bottom line business. Transit must attract ridership to generate fare revenues to provide a justifiable percentage of its operating costs. As a transit rider, and former Director of Planning for RTD, I know RTD's riding clientele, patterns, and demographics. I also worked on the RTD Operator Union-Bidding Assignments and understand transit business decisions regarding union contract negotiations and the necessity for regularly planned driver straight and split shifts and overtime. This knowledge is critical at this time as RTD is entering into contract negotiations with drivers and maintenance employees. I also understand the government relations, reports, regulations, and funding provided RTD by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), Department of Transportation (DOT), Caltrans, the San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG), Stockton, and local county municipalities. Having procured both maintenance and bus equipment and Zero Emission Buses (ZEV) for Stockton Unified (SUSD), and designed fixed route services for RTD's electric ZEV buses, I understand modern day clean air bus transportation implementation, advantages, and challenges such as quick terminal and depot charging. I understand the cost and budgeting of fleet maintenance and the importance (necessity) of preventive scheduled maintenance and fleet renewal. Having produced mandatory RTD reports for SJCOG Unmet Transit Needs, Caltrans Energy and Emissions Reports, and Federal Title VI, Short Range Transit Plans, and Demographic - Ridership and Fare Structure Reports, I will make informed and practical decisions regarding RTD's Executive, Management, Operations, Capital, Staff, and Community Relations decisions that will move the District forward in a purposeful and visionary pathway. I can bring clarity and integrity to Board and Executive actions to enhance RTD's standing in our community and the transit industry.
