RESOLUTION AMENDING THE LIST OF CLASSES APPROVED FOR ALTERNATE STAFFING TO MOVE THE DEPUTY CITY CLERK I/II CLASSIFICATION FROM DISCRETIONARY TO DEEP CLASS

That the Director of Human Resources is hereby authorized to move the Deputy City Clerk I/II classification to the deep class category on the list of classes approved for alternate staffing.
