## RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ANNUAL ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26, THE BUDGET FOR EACH ZONE, AND CONFIRMING ASSESSMENTS FOR THE STOCKTON CONSOLIDATED STORM DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 2005-1

On April 15, 2025, the City Council adopted its Resolution of Intention to Approve the Annual Engineer's Report (Annual Report) for the 2025-26 Fiscal Year, to Provide Preliminary Approval of the Proposed Budgets for each Zone, and to Set a Public Hearing Thereon (Resolution No. 2025-04-15-1202) for the Stockton Consolidated Storm Drainage Maintenance Assessment District No. 2005-1 as required by law; and

Notice of the Public Hearing held on June 3, 2025, was published in The Record, in the time, form, and manner required by law, as evidenced by the declaration on file with the City Clerk; and

At the Public Hearing, every interested person was given an opportunity to make a protest for each Zone to the Annual Report, to the maximum annual assessment, to the actual 2025-26 assessment, to the proposed budget, or to the proposed method and proportion of assessment, either in writing or orally, and this Council has considered each protest and all matters and things pertaining to the Annual Report were fully heard and considered by this Council; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Protests or objections (including all written protests not withdrawn in writing before the conclusion of the Public Hearing) to the proposed levy of assessments in each Zone have not been made by the owners of more than fifty percent of the area of assessable lands within the District in each Zone and such protests or objections are hereby overruled.

2. The Annual Report on file with the City Clerk for the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Stockton Consolidated Storm Drainage Maintenance Assessment District No. 2005-1, which includes the budget for each Zone, is hereby approved and adopted as the method of assessment for each Zone to be used to pay the costs and expenses of the maintenance and operation.

3. The assessment of the annual amount of costs and expenses of the maintenance and operation of the improvements, upon the several subdivisions of land in the District as contained in the Annual Report, be, and the same is hereby approved and confirmed and shall be levied and collected for the Fiscal Year 2025-26.

A. The assessment follows all laws pertaining to the levy of the annual assessment (Section 4 of Article XIIID of the California State Constitution, § 53753.5 of the Gov. Code of the State of California, Streets and Highways Code § 10000, *et seq.*, and the Stockton Improvement Procedure Code).

The City of Stockton hereby certifies that the special assessment(s), fee(s), or charges(s) listed below to be placed on the 2025-26 Secured Property Tax bill by the City of Stockton meets the requirements of Proposition 218 that added Articles XIIIC and XIIID to the California State Constitution.

B. The assessment is levied without regard to property valuation.

C. The purpose of the assessment is the maintenance and operation of storm drainage facilities.

4. The City Manager is authorized to direct the Chief Financial Officer or his/her designee to enter the assessments on the 2025-26 tax roll for the parcels in each Zone within the District as set forth in the Annual Report on file with the City Clerk.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
