# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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## **RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS, APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE11-23, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE FONG PARK PHASE II PROJECT**

On December 19, 2024, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Fong Park Phase II, Project No. WP13207; and

The project will improve the remaining two acres of the park site with concrete walkways, solar pathway lighting, waterwise landscaping, benches, and trash receptacles. The project also includes converting the existing Phase I conventional sodium halide pathway lighting to all solar to match the Phase II improvements; and

McFadden Construction, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,117,606.00 and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15304(b) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$127,632.38 from the Stockton Consolidated Landscape Maintenance Assessment District No. 96-2 Reserves for Continuing Appropriations Accounts to the Fong Park Phase II, Project No. WP13207.

2. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE11-23 under the CEQA for the Fong Park Phase II, Project No. WP13207, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Fong Park Phase II, Project No. WP13207.

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and McFadden Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$1,117,606.00, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
