RESOLUTION AMENDING THE LIST OF CLASSES APPROVED FOR ALTERNATE STAFFING TO MOVE THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER CLASSIFICATION SERIES FROM AUTOMATIC TO DEEP CLASS

The Civil Service Commission has approved a list of classifications for alternate staffing for positions that are hard to fill; and

The Director of Human Resources has recommended that the Code Enforcement Officer classification series be moved from the automatic to the deep class category; and

Due to the shortage of qualified applicants and the continuing need to retain experienced employees; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

That the Director of Human Resources is hereby authorized to move the Code Enforcement Officer classification series to the deep class category on the list of classes approved for alternate staffing.
