RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A SAFER OUTCOMES: ENHANCING DE-ESCALATION AND CRISIS RESPONSE TRAINING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT AWARD FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000

In June 2025, the Stockton Police Department submitted a grant application for the project title: FY 2025 Safer Outcomes program to fund the expansion of de-escalation and crisis response training; and

The Program is administered by the United States Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS); and

The grant provides funding to expand law enforcement training in de-escalation tactics and improving officer response to individuals experiencing behavioral health or suicidal crises, strengthening participation on crisis intervention teams, and building partnerships with community-based service providers; and

In October 2025, the COPS Office notified SPD that the City of Stockton was selected to receive a Safer Outcomes grant award in the amount of \$500,000 with no local match required; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to accept the United States Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services grant award in the amount of \$500,000 for the period October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2027, and make all necessary appropriations in compliance with and for the purposes stated in the grant application.

2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute the Community Oriented Policing Services grant and all related documents to carry out the purpose and intent of the grant award, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The Fiscal Year 2025-26 Annual Budget is amended to appropriate \$500,000 in revenues and expenditures in the Police Department Special Grants account to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
