RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A SAFER OUTCOMES: ENHANCING DE-ESCALATION AND CRISIS RESPONSE TRAINING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT AWARD FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000

In June 2025, the Stockton Police Department submitted a grant application for the project title: FY 2025 Safer Outcomes program to fund the expansion of de-escalation and crisis response training; and

The Program is administered by the United States Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS); and

The grant provides funding to expand law enforcement training in de-escalation tactics and improving officer response to individuals experiencing behavioral health or suicidal crises, strengthening participation on crisis intervention teams, and building partnerships with community-based service providers; and

In October 2025, the COPS Office notified SPD that the City of Stockton was selected to receive a Safer Outcomes grant award in the amount of \$500,000 with no local match required; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to accept the United States Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services grant award in the amount of \$500,000 for the period October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2027, and make all necessary appropriations in compliance with and for the purposes stated in the grant application.
- 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute the Community Oriented Policing Services grant and all related documents to carry out the purpose and intent of the grant award, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 3. The Fiscal Year 2025-26 Annual Budget is amended to appropriate \$500,000 in revenues and expenditures in the Police Department Special Grants account to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
