## STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER NO. 4 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,470,000 WITH SORACCO INC. FOR ON-CALL UTILITY REPAIR SERVICES FOR CITYWIDE WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS

The Municipal Utilities Department (MUD) staff maintain, inspect, and repair collection and water distribution systems as part of the regular maintenance program required to safely transport wastewater for treatment at facilities owned and operated by the City and distribute drinking water to customers in north and south Stockton; and

In June 2022, by Resolution 2022-06-21-1205, the City Council awarded a contract to Soracco Inc. for on-call utility repair services to wastewater collection systems with pipelines smaller than 24 inches in diameter. Contracted services allow staff to respond to large-scale and emergency repairs in a safe and timely manner; and

To respond in a timely manner to larger scale and emergency pipeline and infrastructure repairs, MUD has negotiated Contract Change Order (CCO) No.4 to extend the contract term by two (2) years; and

Staff recommend that the City Council adopt a resolution to approve CCO No. 4 with Soracco, Inc. for on-call utility repair services in the amount of \$6,470,000 for a total contract amount of \$14,700,000; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Contract Change Order No. 4 with Soracco, Inc. in the not-to-exceed total amount of \$14,700,000 is hereby approved, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
