RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FEDERAL COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000

The City Manager authorized staff to apply for a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) FY2023-Community Project Funding Grant (CPF) opportunity in the amount of \$500,000; and

On July 17, 2025, staff received the executed grant award and letter from HUD for B-24-CP-CA-0209 Grantee: City of Stockton, in the amount of \$500,000, to support the Van Buskirk Park Renovation project; and

The HUD CPF Grant Agreement, B-24-CP-CA-0209, will fund a portion of the first phase of the project for environmental planning and design requirements; and

The first phase of the Van Buskirk Park renovation will focus on resurfacing the existing basketball courts, creation of two new basketball courts, and construction of a new skate park, pump track, bike and walking trails including all associated landscape planting, irrigation, lighting, fencing and site furnishing for those recreational features; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Authorize the City Manager to execute a grant agreement from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) FY2023-Community Project Funding Grant (CPF) opportunity in the amount of \$500,000 (Exhibit 1).
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to appropriate grant revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$500,000.
- 3. Authorize the City Manager to execute and manage contractor agreements and consultant agreements in amounts consistent with the Grant Agreement.

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4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.	are
