# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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## **RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE18-25, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE CITY STREET RE-STRIPING FISCAL YEAR 2024-25 SB1, PROJECT NO. WD25009**

On May 8, 2025, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the City Street Re-Striping Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-25 SB1, Project No. WD25009; and

The project will re-stripe 28 intersections Citywide and four centerline miles of arterial and collector roads. The improvements include lane line striping, refreshing crosswalks, limit lines, and pavement legends that are worn; and

Chrisp Company is the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$301,867.50; and

The project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$80,000 from the Gas Tax fund balance to the City Street Re-Striping FY 2024-25 SB1, Project No. WD25009.

2. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE18-25 under the CEQA for the City Street Re-Striping FY 2024-25 SB1, Project No. WD25009, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the City Street Re-Striping FY 2024-25 SB1, Project No. WD25009.

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Chrisp Company, in the amount of \$301,867.50, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

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5. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
