RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF STOCKTON AND THE STOCKTON FIREFIGHTERS' LOCAL 456 FIRE UNIT AND THE STOCKTON FIREFIGHTERS' LOCAL 456 FIRE MANAGEMENT UNIT AND AUTHORIZING ITS IMPLEMENTATION

The City's negotiating team met and conferred with officials of the Stockton Firefighters' Local 456 Fire Unit and the Stockton Firefighters' Local 456 Fire Management Unit and reached a tentative agreement for a successor Memoranda of Understanding. On June 26, 2026, the Fire and Fire Management Units ratified the agreements by a majority vote of their members; and

The City of Stockton and the Stockton Firefighters' Local 456 Fire and Fire Management Units have in good faith completed their meet and confer obligations regarding their successor Memorandum of Understanding. Human Resources and the Administrative Services Department have conducted a comprehensive review of the existing Memoranda of Understanding and have recommended revisions to salary and administrative provisions; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Memoranda of Understanding between the City of Stockton and the Stockton Firefighters' Local 456 Fire and Fire Management Units is attached hereto as Exhibits 1 and 2, and made part hereof by this reference, is hereby approved, and adopted.

2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Stockton Firefighters' Local 456 Fire and Fire Management Units Memoranda of Understanding to be effective July 1, 2026.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to increase expenditure appropriations in the annual budget for Fiscal Year 2026-27, as necessary to carry out the intent of the agreements as shown in Exhibit 3.
